About the Service

BID Services deliver a range of specialist support to people living in Solihull who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind, visually impaired or have a dual sensory loss. We also provide support to families, carers, professionals and other organisations, working together to improve the lives of Solihull residents and helping them to remain independent. The service supports people aged 18 and over as well as young people transitioning from children's services.

About the partnership

We are working as part of Solihull First, a broad partnership of voluntary and community organisations working together with people who use their services. The new approach will promote self-care and independence, making it easier for people to find information and advice, as well as providing specialist support for those who need it.

Our Services

Social Work

We provide specialised, professional social work services to deaf, deafened and hard of hearing adults and young people over the age of 17 who are in transition. We offer the full spectrum of services, including person centred assessments, support planning, reviews and signposting to other services.

Assistive Equipment

For deaf and hard of hearing people, our Technical Officer can undertake assessments to help people access equipment for use in the home. For those with mobility issues, assessments can be carried out in the home. Information available on request.

Rehabilitation

BID's Rehabilitation Officer supports clients to plan for a future of living as independently as possible with sight loss. Support can include mobility and orientation training and daily living skills.

We can offer a range of information and guidance using different communication styles to meet your needs. This service is available at the following locations:
