BSL Level 3

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to improve their communication and fluency in BSL.

It acts as a progression route for those with BSL Level 2 and leads the way towards advanced level of study in BSL.

BSL Level 6 Certificate in British Sign Language

This course is designed for those who want to earn a higher qualification that enables them to work with deaf people. It can be used as evidence of the necessary language skills that are needed to work at a professional level.
